

ENGAGING THE COMMUNITY

Recommendations from “Engaging the Community” process

1. Leave West Sechelt as is, K-7. Cap their enrollment total or adjust the boundary so as not to create an overcrowding situation.
2. Combine the school populations of Davis Bay, Sechelt and Kinnikinnick into one facility.
3. Pursue the Neighbourhood’s of Learning option as well as recommendation two, not instead of recommendation 2.
4. Present the information to the public in the same way it was presented to the EtC committee.
5. Post the information from the EtC process on the District’s website.
6. The Board needs to decide on the best site with necessary input from senior staff.
7. Move forward, no more waiting to make the decision.
8. End the middle school concept with regards to a separate building.
9. Submit a timely letter to the editor about the process and about the outcome.
10. Make it happen, sooner than later.
11. Let the public know that the EtC process was inclusive and extensive ie: list all the groups represented from each school.
12. Use those EtC members, who indicated, to help field questions from the community.
13. Deliver the same message from everyone.
14. No more status quo, it is not good for kids.
15. Rename the “new” School.
16. Gather the individual school traditions to bring to the new school.
