Student Bus Transportation Guidelines

Courtesy Riders

Courtesy riders are students who:

- * are not eligible for regular school bus transportation because they live within the prescribed walk limits of their school:
 - Elementary students: within 2.0 kilometers from their home school
 - Secondary students: within 3.2 kilometers from their home school

Note: *Students who live on Gambier and Keats Islands and in the community of Woodcreek Park are exempt from this guideline.*

These students are permitted to ride school buses on existing routes as courtesy riders provided there are seats available and only with the understanding of the following conditions:

- * the courtesy rider system is not a scheduled service;
- * it may be discontinued at any time if conditions change;
- * the courtesy rider may be bumped by an eligible rider;
- * the bus contractor will give notice of cancellation of courtesy services affecting significant numbers of students.

Cross-Boundary Riders

The Board of Education also reaffirmed its policy not to provide transportation to cross-boundary students except in the following circumstances:

- Elphinstone and Chatelech Secondary School students living in the Roberts Creek Elementary School catchment area;
- Students in the Sechelt Elementary School catchment area attending Kinnikinnick Elementary School and students in the West Sechelt Elementary School catchment area currently attending Kinnikinnick Elementary School;
- Students from Halfmoon Bay Elementary School catchment area attending Pender Harbour Secondary School.
