



## Governance Policies

### 3.0 BOARD-STAFF RELATIONSHIP

#### 3.1 AUTHORITY THAT IS DELEGATED TO THE SUPERINTENDENT

All Board authority that is delegated to staff shall be delegated through the Superintendent, so that all authority and accountability of staff, as far as the Board is concerned, is considered to be the authority and accountability of the Superintendent.

Consequently:

- 3.1.1 The Board determines the degree of authority delegated to the Superintendent through its policies and authorizes the Superintendent to lead and manage the school district in compliance with these policies.
- 3.1.2 Only decisions of the Board acting as a corporate body are binding upon the Superintendent. Decisions or instructions of individual Board members, representatives, or task groups are not binding on the Superintendent except in rare instances when the Board has specifically assigned such authority.
- 3.1.3 The Board shall delegate to the Superintendent the responsibility of developing administrative regulations. All administrative regulations shall be cross-referenced to their corresponding Ministry Order or Board Policy. Regulations shall be developed, circulated and approved as per Regulation No. 1730.
