COURTESY RIDERS

Courtesy riders are students who:

- are not eligible for regular school bus transportation because they live within the prescribed walk limits of their school:
 - Elementary students: within 2.0 kilometers from their home school
 - Secondary students: within 3.2 kilometers from their home school

These students are permitted to ride school buses on existing routes as courtesy riders provided there are seats available and only with the understanding of the following conditions:

- the courtesy rider system is not a scheduled service;
- it may be discontinued at any time if conditions change;
- the courtesy rider may be bumped by an eligible rider;
- the bus contractor will give notice of cancellation of courtesy services affecting significant numbers of students.

If you wish your child to ride the bus as a courtesy rider, please complete the application form and submit it to:
